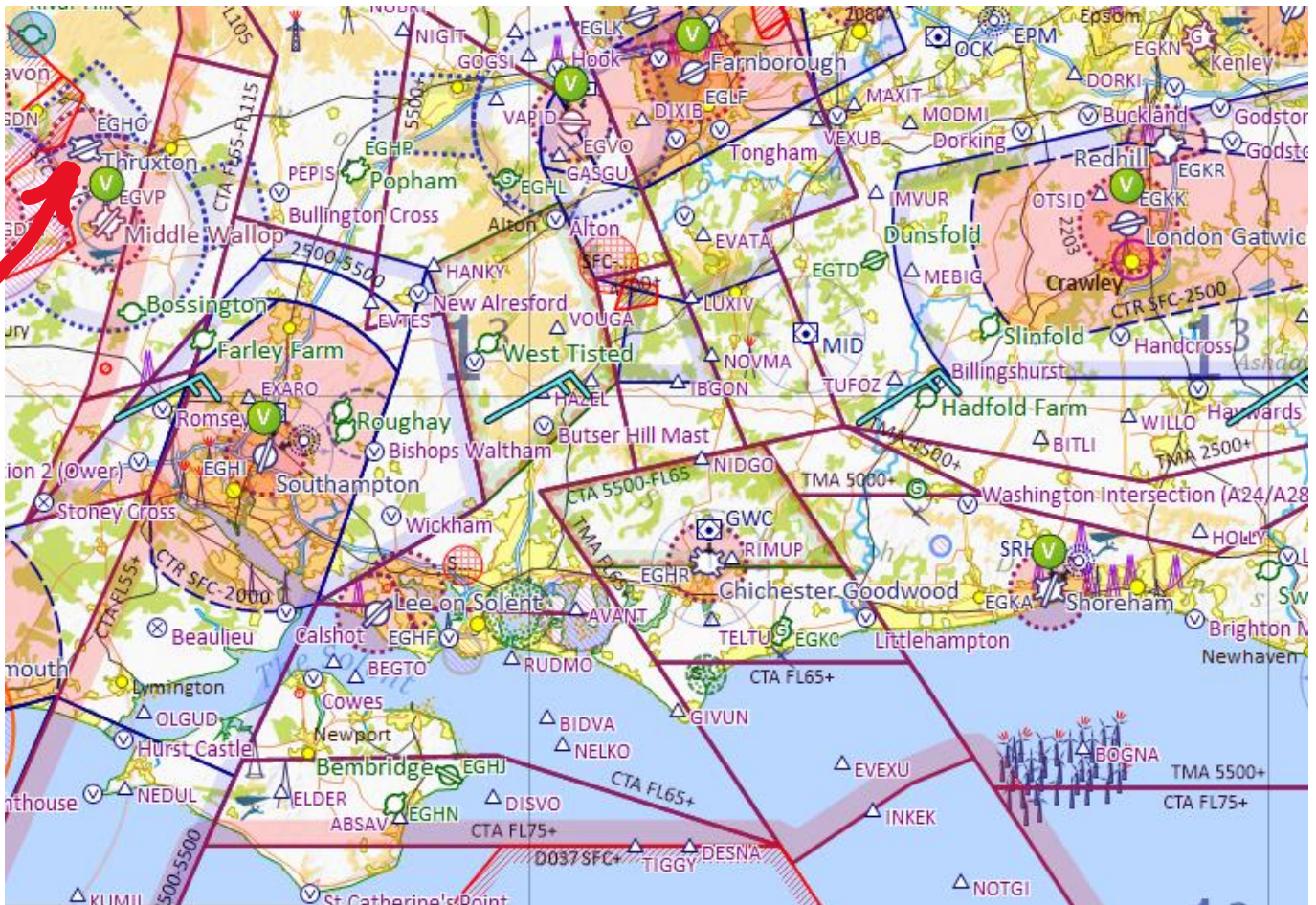


Breakfast Fly-Out

On Sunday 12th September 2021, Redhill Aero Club will be having its second Breakfast Fly-Out of 2021. The plan is to meet up at Redhill for a departure to Thruxton airfield in Hampshire shortly after 9:00am (local).

We won't be too rushed; it's a relatively short flight and the café at Thruxton only opens at 10:00am. But with a smartish departure, of course, one could still make it by flying down to the Isle of Wight and then north from the Needles.

We aim to return to Redhill by 12:30 local.



Thruxton is a straight-forward destination except that it sits IN the Boscome MATZ. The controllers there are a friendly bunch – give them a call for penetration and they will hand you over to Thruxton at the appropriate time.

Another thing to note while planning – in mid-July the HIRTA at Oakhanger was halved in size. There is now a sensible gap between it and the Odiham MATZ which makes the route a little easier.

We do hope for good weather but will only proceed if it is good VMC.

Club aircraft and, if necessary, instructors are available to be booked for the event. In particular we encourage qualified pilots to “buddy up” and share the flying duties. If anyone is looking for a flying partner the ops team will be delighted to help pair them up.

This event is not limited to Redhill Aero Club and its members. We wish to invite all other flyers at Redhill, and indeed elsewhere, to join us. Please spread the word.
